Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to,

- staff to respond to initial request for service
- arrangement conference with family
- arrangement of funeral and/or memorial service
- preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits, e.g. death certificates
- recording of vital statistics
- preparation and placement of obituary notices
- coordination with those providing other portions of arrangements, [e.g. cemetery, crematory, vault companies, and other as required]
- notification of social security
- filing for veteran benefits
- Care of remains at funeral home [storage of remains]
- Insurance Processing & Guide to closing an estate

Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities, such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds maintenance, visitors lounge, building maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory, costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.
