Amelio Paraventi, 96, of Howell, Michigan, died peacefully at his home with his family surrounding him on March 3, 2010.

Beloved husband of the late Vera(Applin). Dear father of Robyn (Daniel) Hermes, Jody (Mark) Leveille, and Andrew (Julie) Paraventi, and five grandchildren, Heather (Clint) Rottermond, Colleen Hermes, Nickolas Leveille, Maxine Paraventi, and Bryce Leveille.

Amelio was born in Iron River, Michigan on November 4, 1913 to Pasquale and Rose Paraventi. Survived by his brother Pete (Ruth). He was preceded in death by his brothers Joseph and Nano, and his sisters Ada Sgiecci and Eva Paraventi.

Amelio grew up in Iron River, MI during the Great Depression and went to work for the Civilian Conservation Corps. He served in the Medical Corps for the Army during World War II in Texas. Afterwards, he moved with Vera to Seattle, Washington and repaired battleships and destroyers returning from the Pacific Theatre. When the War was over, he and Vera moved to Detroit where he worked as an ironworker for Local 25. Some of the many projects he worked on were The Mackinaw Bridge and The Ren Center in Detroit. Upon retiring from Local 25 they moved to Howell, MI to spend their golden years overlooking a beautiful lake. He and Vera were longstanding members of St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Howell.
