Her Legacy... Brashares, Anne H., age 88 of Jackson, formally of Brooklyn, passed away on June 2, 2010. Anne was born on January 11, 1922 in Jackson the daughter of Philip O. Lathrop and Gladys (Herrington) Lathrop. On March 11, 1944 she married Dr. Zane Brashares, MD and he preceded her in death. Anne graduated from the Blodgett School of Nursing in Grand Rapids, MI and worked in the Brooklyn area as a Registered Nurse alongside her husband and will be remembered fondly. She was a longtime member of the Brooklyn Presbyterian Church and the direct descendent of George Howland Lathrop Sr., an early Jackson Pioneer.
